- Please give or email the Scoutmaster a copy of your certificate for any training you take.
- Go to my.scouting.org, then Menu/My Dashboard [My Training]—This should have a link to Youth Protection
  Training.
- From My Dashboard/My Training, click on Training Center, then Scouts BSA—This should give you links below to Merit Badge Counselor Training, Scoutmaster [& ASM] Training, and Troop Committee Training.
- Or from **Scouts BSA**, click on **Course Catalog** (at top), then on **Program Safety** (near bottom) to get to the safety-related courses (you may need to click on a second Program Safety link to get to the courses).

- Youth Protection Training—BSA requirements designed to keep Scouts safe from abuse. Required for all adults who have any contact with the Scouts. Just over an hour total for all three modules. Valid for 2 years.
- Merit Badge Counselor Training—New training course for all merit badge counselors (recommended but not yet required for all merit badge counselors). About 53 minutes total for both modules. Valid indefinitely??
- Scoutmaster & Assistant Scoutmaster Position Specific Training—Online part of training required for all SMs & ASMs (followed by classroom trainings below). About 3 hours total for all three modules. Valid indefinitely.
- **Troop Committee Training**—Online required training for all troop committee members. About 2 hours 40 minutes total for all three modules. Valid indefinitely.
- **Hazardous Weather**—Safety precautions for different types of potentially dangerous weather. Required of all Scoutmaster/Assistant Scoutmasters, and all adults on a troop trek. Valid for 2 years.
- Safe Swim Defense & Safety Afloat—Key principles for conducting a safe swim activity; and the key principles for conducting a safe canoeing, sailing, or other activity afloat. Valid for 2 years.
- Trek Safely—Covers key safety points about trekking. Required for all adults on a troop trek. Valid for 2 years.
- Drive Safely—Covers safe driving practices. Recommended for all leaders & parents. Valid for 2 years??
- Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills/IOLS—Covers the outdoor aspects of the Scout program. Valid indefinitely. Provided by local district; lasts one weekend.
